Kalasa Puja, Ganapathi Homam, Sri Bala Ganapathi Moola Mantram, Poornahuti and Aarthi.

EVENING: 7:00 PM - 8:30 PM

Kalasa Puja, Maha Sankalpam (for sponsors), Ganapathi Abhishekam, Utsavam, Aarthi and Prasadam.

SRI BALA GANAPATHI - The First among the 34 types of Ganesha. He is the child form, who is depicted with 4 hands (chaturbhuj).

SIGNIFICANCE: Sri Bala Ganapathi, shines in golden color like a rising sun. He holds a mango with his right lower hand, bananas in right upper hand, jackfruit in left lower hand, and sugarcane with left upper hand. He appears with a Modak in his trunk.

The appearance of Sri Bala Ganapathi represents the importance of agriculture and the nature in this universe. He signifies his influence on the abundance and fertility of the earth.
